"It is our first venture into a regional area with such a large group," Mr Gilbert said.

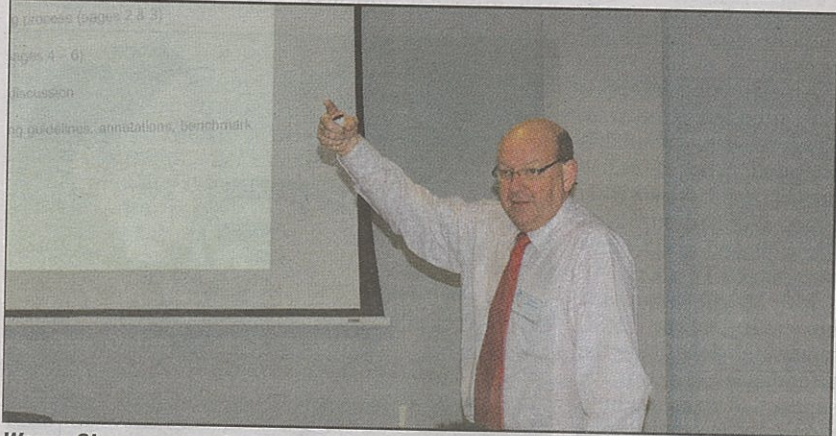
"We are talking about good teaching practice and are covering many areas, including family law.
