Quizmaster Instructions

1. Cut out the large square and place the paper face down on the table.
2. Fold in half 4 times – including diagonally. Try to fold as accurately as possible or your quizmaster will not come together very well. Make sure you pinch each fold as you go.
3. Open out your paper again and leave face down. Fold all corners to the centre of the page making sure all points meet.
4. Turn your quizmaster over and fold the corners into the centre again.
5. Now fold your paper in half vertically and horizontally, then insert your fingers under the tabs.
6. Finally, you will need to make a cut between each pair of titles so that only one answer is shown when revealed.

You will need a partner to play this quiz.

Players will each take five turns to quiz each other on their knowledge of the rule of law.

The player with the most correct answers wins!
