The Primary Responsibility of the A-G is to protect the rule of law and the integrity of the Courts.

"It is the special role of the Attorney-General to be the voice within the government and to the public which articulates, and insists upon observance of, the enduring principles of legal justice, and upon respect for the judicial and other legal institutions through which they are applied."

Job Description

To protect the rule of law, the A-G must ensure that the laws are **applied equally and fairly** to everyone. This means that the A-G must ensure all people, no matter their background, status, religion, or gender have equal access to the courts and the ability to resolve disputes fairly and efficiently. The AG must ensure those in power, particularly fellow politicians and members of the executive, do not unfairly use their position or resources and the model litigant rules apply.

The A-G must ensure that **proper legal processes** are followed to ensure the integrity of the legal system is maintained. This means that guilt can only be found in a court that is governed by the rules of evidence, the presumption of innocence and the safeguard of appeals.

Finally, the A-G must be the **voice for the rule of law** and instill public confidence. It is the responsibility of the A-G to speak out when the principles of the rule of law are being eroded and to ensure community support of these foundations. The A-G must support education programs to promote informed citizenry and a culture of lawfulness that support the rule of law.
