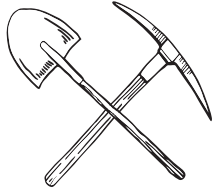

The Eureka Rebellion Chatterbox



You will need a partner to play the Eureka Chatterbox.
Players will take five turns to quiz each other on their knowledge of the Eureka Rebellion.

Assembly Instructions

1. Cut out the large square and place the paper face down on the table.
2. Fold in half 4 times, including diagonally and open after each fold. Fold on the lines as accurately as possible and pinch each fold as you go to help your chatterbox come together.
3. Open out your piece of paper and place face down. Fold all corners to the centre of the page making sure all points meet in the centre, again pinching each fold.
4. Turn your chatterbox over and fold the new corners into the centre.
5. Fold your paper in half vertically and then horizontally, then insert your fingers under the tabs and lift them out.
6. Finally, you will need to make a cut between each wquestion so only one answer is revealed.
