Human rights are recognised by upholding fundamental values and ideals, providing a safe, secure and progressive society where all citizens have freedom of choice.

1901 Australian Federation

The Westminster system provides the blueprint to administer a representative democracy.

As outlined in the Constitution, power is shared between the parliament, executive, and an independent judiciary. Each branch works within defined areas of responsibility. Mechanisms are in place to maintain accountability and guard against one group holding power over another.
