Public Health Act 2010 NSW



POWER TO GIVE ORDERS

If the Minister considers on reasonable grounds there is a risk to public health the Minister may by order give such directions, to deal with the risk and its possible consequences.

SAFEGUARDS

Public Health Orders are not a Statutory Rules, so usual safeguards for Delegated Legislation such as Regulatory Impact Statements, consultation and ability to disallow the rules do not apply.

Instead the Public Health Act includes the below safeguards for health orders:

- Order must be published in the Gazette
- Order expires at the end of 90 days after it was made or on such earlier date as may be specified in the order.
- An application may be made to the Civil and Administrative Tribunal for an administrative review
