This resource compares the health of the rule of law in Israel and in Australia by using an indicator provided by Global Economy.Com.

Unless otherwise indicated, a point score closer to -2.5 is weak, whereas a point score of 2.5 is strong. A global rank of 1/192 is more favourable than a rank of 192/192



Rule of Law Index - Comparing Israel and Australia Overtime












